

FROM THE PRESIDENT

ere we go again! Just when you think you have seen everything, along comes 2021!

The hopes of 2021 brought us the belief that the COVID-19 pandemic would be in our rearview mirror and life would return to normal. Instead, the virus threw us a curveball, mutating into the delta variant, which has extended and even exacerbated COVID-19 protocols throughout the nation. The unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic unfortunately had and will have far-reaching effects on our families as we fight for our health, as well as economic and

employment concerns. The toll on our society continues — mentally, physically, emotionally, politically and economically.

Health concerns, uncertainty and a variety of COVID-19 vaccination mandates provided voluminous challenges and difficulties during 2021. However, PPOA tackled these issues head-on from the beginning, taking actions such as:

- Allocating extensive resources to the COVID-19 pandemic and related legal issues since March 2020, meeting with our staff and legal team twice a week
- Gathering legal opinions and consulting with counsel from the Fraternal Order of Police, the California Coalition of Law Enforcement Associations and the Peace Officers Research Association of California
- Continuing to demand accommodation and/or testing options for our members who are not seeking a medical and/or religious exemption
- Beginning the mediation process with our labor partners of the Coalition of County Unions (CCU) to address the unreasonableness of the County's vaccination mandate and timeline

2021 also saw continued efforts to reform the criminal justice system and law enforcement through defunding and legislation.

PPOA's efforts, in collaboration with our law enforcement coalition partners, were successful in mitigating the legislative impact on our profession. Additionally, PPOA and our partners of the CCU were successful in court as a judge overturned Measure J, deeming it unconstitutional. The measure would have reduced funding to the County criminal justice system by approximately 10% over three years. Thank you to our CCU partners in their support of legal challenges.

The year 2021 marked the 70th anniversary of PPOA. We should thank those who came before us in this organization for the many contributions they have provided to us as members today. One such person, John Fleming, one of our original members who served as a Board member and legislative liaison, recently passed. His participation and dedication to this organization were critical in the early years and were reflected in his continued involvement with PPOA throughout his retirement.

As we express our gratitude, PPOA is extremely grateful to the many vendors who provide services to our members and support our organization. Should you need assistance, all you need to do is look through our *Star & Shield* magazine, PPOA website or call the office to contact these dedicated professionals who provide our members with extraordinary services and support.

Finally, this report would not be complete without a huge *thank-you* to the PPOA staff for their hard work and commitment to our members, especially during these pandemic years. The PPOA team has worked to ensure we are providing the best services of any labor organization. PPOA members are indebted to them for providing services to us with such a high level of professionalism and care.

PPOA members will undoubtedly face more hurdles in 2022, but make no mistake, PPOA will be here to help. LEGAL REPRESENTATION

Labor Representatives

The most important role of a union is to safeguard the job and rights of every member. PPOA takes this role extremely seriously — that's why experienced labor representatives are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week for our members. PPOA's team of seasoned professionals assists members on a daily basis with grievances, IAB interviews, administrative appeals hearings (including *Skelly*) and more. Every member of the PPOA defense rep team has more than 25 years of experience with L.A. County law enforcement and labor representation.

Attorneys

PPOA members benefit from the expertise of attorneys specializing in everything from workers' compensation to the Peace Officers' Bill of Rights. Every active PPOA member is afforded representation from an attorney for ERCOM/civil service, use of force and shootings. Our legal experts hail from distinguished law firms throughout Southern California. (A list of the firms affiliated with PPOA is on page 32.)

Free Non-Job-Related Legal Advice

Protecting your interests at home is important, too. That's why every PPOA member is entitled to a free one-hour consultation each year with an attorney to discuss matters not related to work.

Legal Defense Plan

All active PPOA members are enrolled in the Fraternal Order of Police Legal Defense Plan. This plan provides defense coverage for civil and criminal actions arising in the scope of law enforcement duties. The coverage has no limits on defense costs when using a plan attorney, although members do have the right to choose their own attorney (subject to deductible and cost limit).

Bargaining Units

PPOA is the exclusive bargaining agent for thousands of employees of the L.A. County Sheriff's Department, the District Attorney's Office and Department of Medical Examiner-Coroner. PPOA is the only union that can negotiate for their wages, hours and working conditions, and only PPOA members have the right to ratify a potential contract.

Salary

Salary contract negotiating teams are composed of rank-and-file PPOA members from each respective bargaining unit. PPOA bargaining units include:

- Unit 612 (Sworn: Sheriff, District Attorney)
- Unit 614 (Professional staff: Sheriff, Medical Examiner-Coroner)
- Unit 621 (Professional staff: Sheriff)
- Unit 631 (Sworn: Medical Examiner-Coroner)
- Unit 632 (Sworn: Medical Examiner-Coroner)

Fringe Benefits

PPOA members receive a number of negotiated fringe benefits from the County of Los Angeles. These countywide benefits are negotiated collectively by 14 county unions (including PPOA) known as the Coalition of County Unions. The benefits include "Choices" medical, dental, vision, vacation, sick leave, "Horizons," holidays and retirement benefits — every one of them vital to the quality of life for PPOA members and their families.

POLITICAL MUSCLE

Legislation

PPOA's record of legislative influence stretches back to the 1960s. Political strategies orchestrated by our Board of Directors and full-time lobbyists in Sacramento have resulted in hundreds of laws being passed that directly affect PPOA members. These include paid time off for line-of-duty injuries; military buyback program in Los Angeles County; Countyissued safety equipment; increased benefits for families of officers killed in the line of duty; confidentiality of peace officer personnel records; medical presumptions (cancer, heart disease, lower-back injuries, MRSA staph infections, etc.) and more.

PPOA's affiliation with the Fraternal Order of Police also affords our members significant political influence at the federal level.

Political Action

PPOA members formed a specialized political action committee (PAC Plus) in 1999 to establish a stronger, more effective presence in local politics, particularly in Los Angeles County. Today, hundreds of PPOA members voluntarily contribute to PAC Plus.
